Infection control has always been a top priority for our practice and you may have seen this during your visits to our office. Our infection control processes are made so that when you receive care, it's both safe and comfortable.

Our office follows infection control recommendations made by the American Dental Association (ADA), the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA). We follow the activities of these agencies so that we are up-to-date on any new rulings or guidance that may be issued. We do this to make sure that our infection control procedures are current and adhere to each agencies' recommendations.

You may see some changes when it is time for your next appointment. We make these changes to help protect our patients and staff. For example:

- We will have you answer some screening questions at your arrival, sign and date the questionnaire.
- We have hand sanitizer for you to use when you enter the office. You will also find some at the exit desk as well.
- We ask that you wear a face mask while not in the operatory room.
- You may see that our reception areas will no longer offer magazines (for now) as those are difficult to clean and disinfect.
- Appointments will be managed to allow for social distancing between patients.
- We will be taking temperatures at each appointment and may have you gargle with hydrogen peroxide for 60 seconds.
- We will do our best to allow greater time between patients to reduce waiting, as well as to reduce the number of patients in the reception area at any one time.
